## School Facebook Page

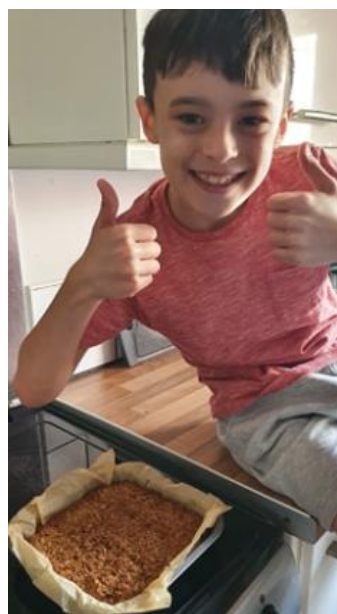
