

New School Meal Price

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you will all be aware, we are currently experiencing high levels of inflation nationally, greater than anyone expected or predicted. Due to this, and to meet the rising costs of providing school meals, a small increase in the price of a meal is now necessary.

From Monday 8th April, the cost of a school meal will increase to **£2.53** per day. This increase will be reflected in the online payment system Bromcom from this date.

This price still represents good value for money for a two-course, freshly cooked school meal that is seasonally aligned and meets the government's school food standards. Our prices remain amongst the lowest when compared with other local schools and we will not make any profit from any meal taken by a child.
