Year Group Information Sheet for Parents – Upper Key Stage 2





Autumn 1

In Upper Key Stage 2, our learning this half-term will see us exploring the much-loved text **Cosmic.** The story follows a young boy called Liam Digby, a tall twelve-year-old who pretends to be a dad to join a space mission. What starts as a funny trick turns into a real adventure, where Liam learns about responsibility, family, and growing up.

In **English** this half-term, pupils will be exploring and using the features of poetry to write and perform for other children around school. We will begin by looking at free verse poetry.

We will be focussing on ensuring that our spelling, punctuation and presentation is to a high standard, as well as learning the features of the text type.

In **Mathematics** this half-term, we will be focussing on place value and roman numerals. We will gain greater independence with reasoning and problemsolving questions.

We will also continue to work on our mental arithmetic. Continuing to practice multiplication tables is essential, to ensure we rapidly recall number facts in our calculations.

In our Topic-driven afternoons we will be:

History

In History, we will compare and contrast space travel technology from the 1960s to the modern day. We will explore the roles of key individuals who were influential to the history of space travel.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning how to use an atlas to locate countries around the world where space programmes exist. We will be able to locate rocket launch sites on a map and describe the human and physical features of those locations.

Science

In Science this half-term, we will be learning about the solar system and how the Sun and Moon affect everyday life, using sundials and investigating phases of the moon.

Art & Design

In Art, we will be exploring the use of watercolours to further our painting techniques. We will develop our skills by designing different planets to create a solar system. In DT, we will learn to use nets and Computer Aided Design to create our own programmable toys.

PSHE & RE

In PSHE, we will understand what discrimination is and reflect on its impact on people's lives. We will then learn about diversity and celebrate our differences by learning how different groups make up and contribute to a community. In RE, we will identify and compare different places of worship for Christianity and Judaism.
